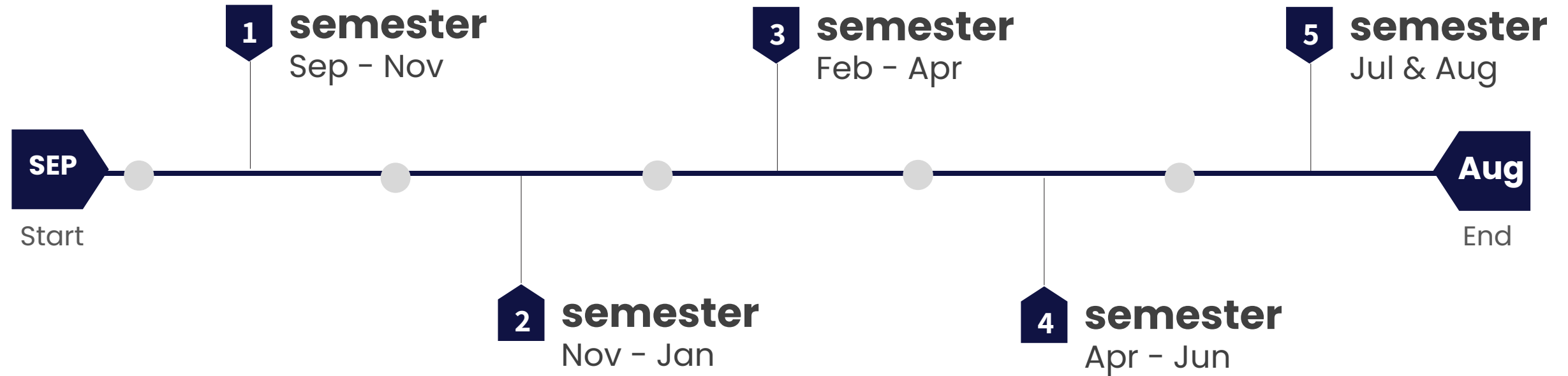


UIS School Year Calendar

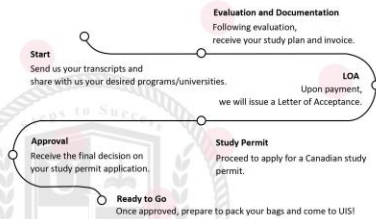

ENGLISH ASSESSMENT TEST ON ORIENTATION DAY

UIS conducts one-on-one academic counselling at site with each student after UIS receives the official final transcript record and English Level Assessment Test. Please note that the original course planning might be subject to change after one-on-one academic counselling at site.

- If the test result is **LOW**; the student will need to take appropriate level of ESL course.
 - AO → BO → CO → DO → EO → Gr. 11 English → Gr. 12 English (Depends on student's level)
 - The number of courses required may be changed depending on the level of assessment.
- If the test result is **HIGH**; students can start with regular courses.

HOW TO APPLY TO UNIVERSITIES IN ONTARIO?

- Ontario Secondary School Diploma
- Six grade 12 courses (student needs to pick the desired program for universities in order for us to advise the courses)
- IELTS or TOEFL result (*IELTS 6.5+)

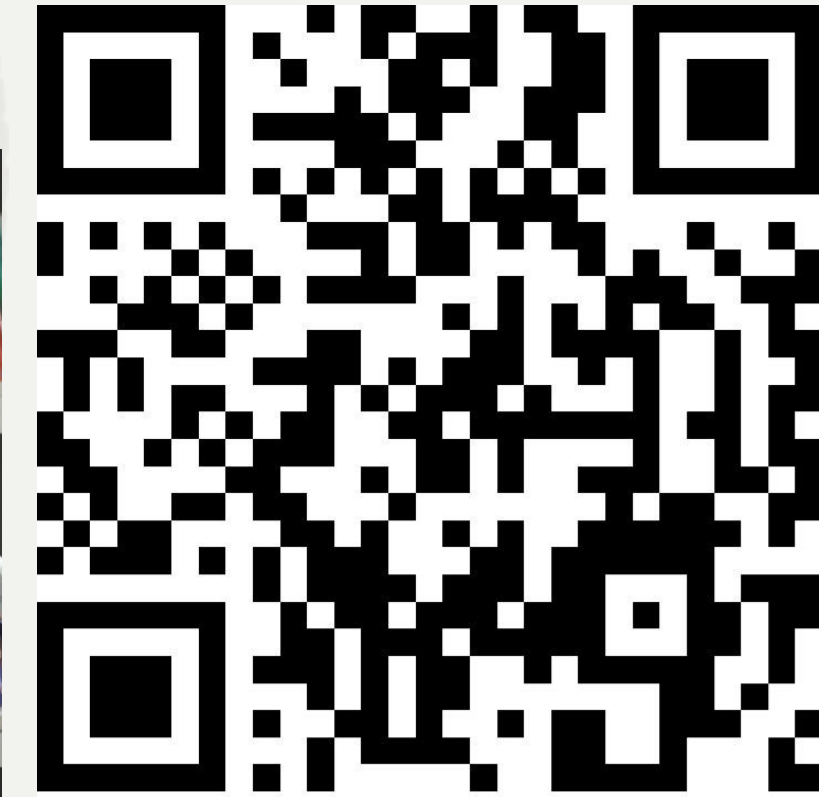
