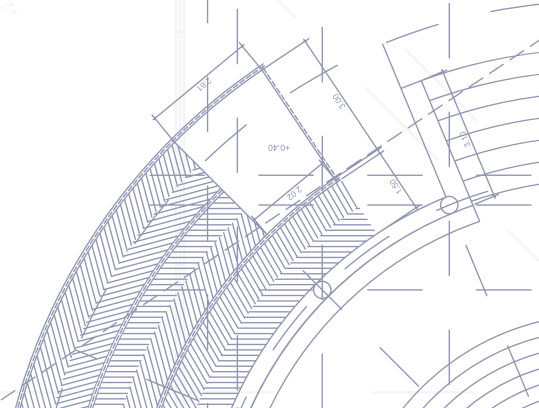
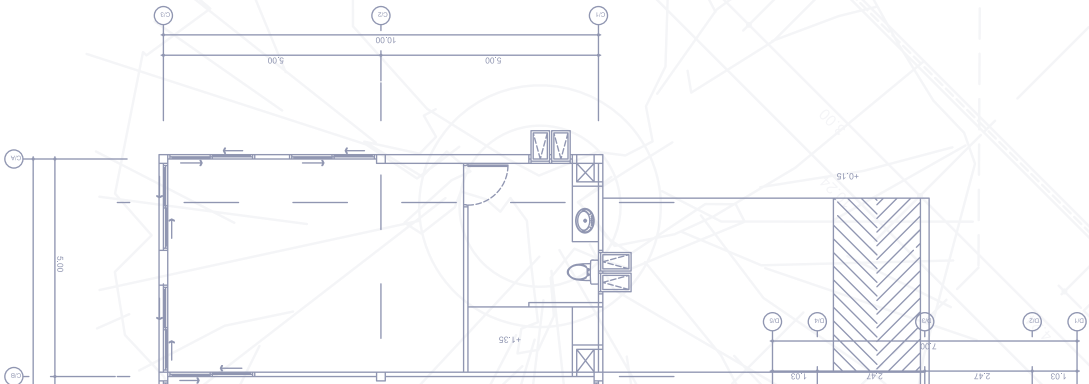

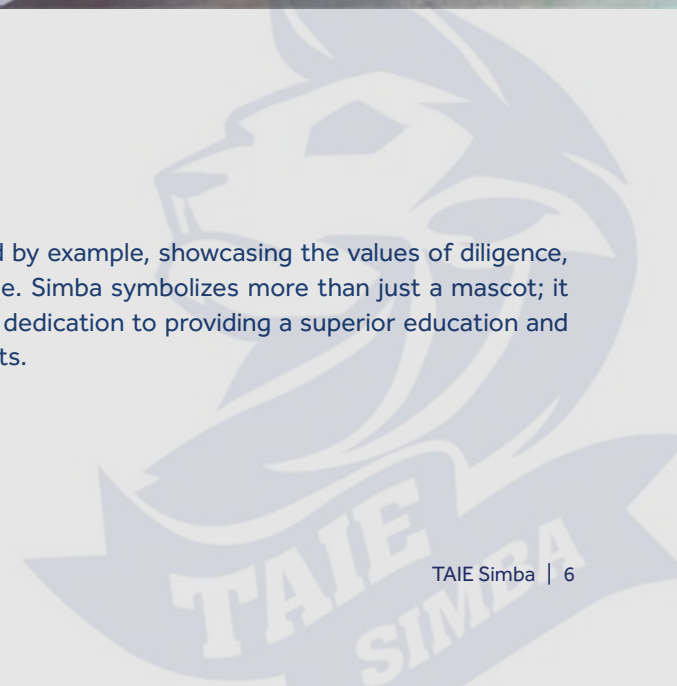

Program Requirements:

- Completion of Grade 6
- Students are required to submit the Grade 1 to Grade 6 report cards and the elementary school graduation certificate.
- No IELTS / TOEFL requirement

Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD)

Program Requirements:

- Graduates from middle schools
- Current students in grades 10, 11 and 12 (or current students in the International Baccalaureate Diploma Program [IBDP, O-level])

Program Introduction:

OSSD courses are designed for students who have not obtained a high school diploma in their home country but have been assessed for equivalent credits. Students who complete Ontario High School courses will receive an Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) and can also apply to Canadian universities and any higher education institutes in the World.

Students who have not graduated high school or who cannot apply to universities in the absence of a high school diploma from their home countries are recommended to take 12 credits per year.

Our Academic Guidance Counsellor will help select these Ontario Secondary School courses, working with these students one-on-one to facilitate their personal study plan. The main high school course areas include: Sciences, English, and Tests scores for university admittance. These courses are also

suitable for students wishing to use their TAIE ENC 4U grades in place of English Proficiency Tests scores for university admittance.

Program Features:

- Following the Ontario Ministry of Education's standards, courses taken in students' home countries can be transferred for credits that are required by the OSSD.
- Courses are a total of 110 hours and can be taken in the morning, afternoon, or evening. The schedule and start date are flexible, which helps our students optimize their energy and time.
- Students can take 12 credits per year.
- Our Academic Guidance Counsellor will help students one-on-one and facilitate their personal study plan.

Students must earn 18 compulsory credits and 12 optional credits to obtain the Ontario Secondary School Diploma.

Credit Transfer

The school will evaluate courses taken in our international students' home countries and require at the minimum, a complete and official transcript for credit transfers. The school will compare the completed courses with Canadian courses, and evaluate the number of equivalent credits for which the student can be granted. The following chart shows an estimation of transferred credits for different grades (Note: this chart is for reference only. Final decisions are made when students present their official transcript to the school.)

University Preparatory Course (UPC)

This course is designed for students who have completed their high school diploma and wish to improve their high school grade average. Students gain valuable skills and expertise, which prepares them well for their post-secondary studies.

Program Requirements:

- Students must have graduated from high school and have already obtained a high school diploma (or graduates of the International Baccalaureate Diploma Program [IBDP], O-level).

Program Introduction:

UPC is a program for international students who have a high school diploma from either their home country or Canada. This course helps students enhance their comprehensive academic abilities and English language skills, ensuring a sufficient foundation before entering university. Students choose 6-credit courses for their university applications based on their career plans. TAIE International Institute provides students with comprehensive courses that serve their interests and meet the prerequisites for their desired university programs.

Before entering UPC, all students will take an English placement test to determine an appropriate English level. Our ESL program builds a solid foundation for students before they start UPC.

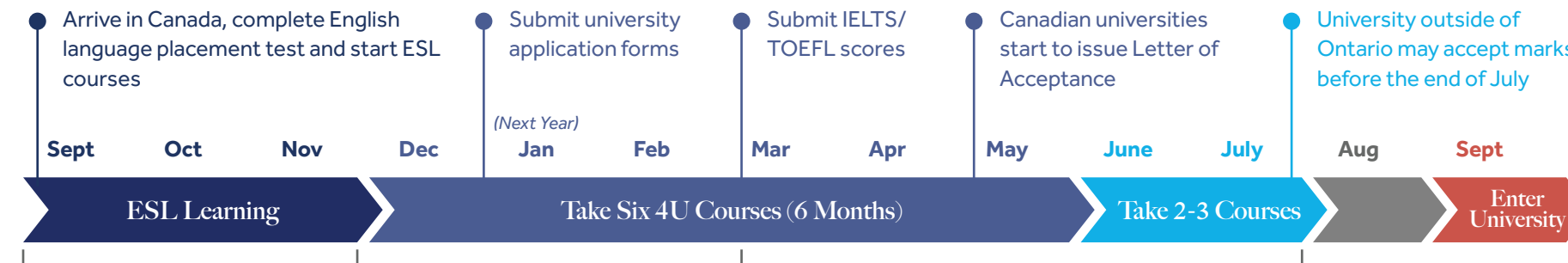
UPC students aim not only to improve their average marks before applying to university but also to develop their confidence with the English language. In doing so, they also adapt to their new cultural environment. Students will work with the TAIE guidance counsellors to meet their university application requirements. The majority of the graduates from our school are admitted to the University of Toronto, University of Alberta, University of Waterloo, Western University, York University, and McMaster University.

Program Features:

- Flexible curriculum schedule allows students to take courses according to their specific needs.
- Completion of six UPC courses within 4-6 months.
- Ability to apply for conditional letters of acceptance to TAIE partner universities and colleges.
- Excellent learning environments with one-on-one or small group tutoring.
- Individual academic counseling helps students fully prepare for university applications.
- Students can have TOEFL and IELTS requirements waived by presenting their marks from grade 12 English (ENG4U) as proof of their English proficiency when applying to TAIE partner schools.

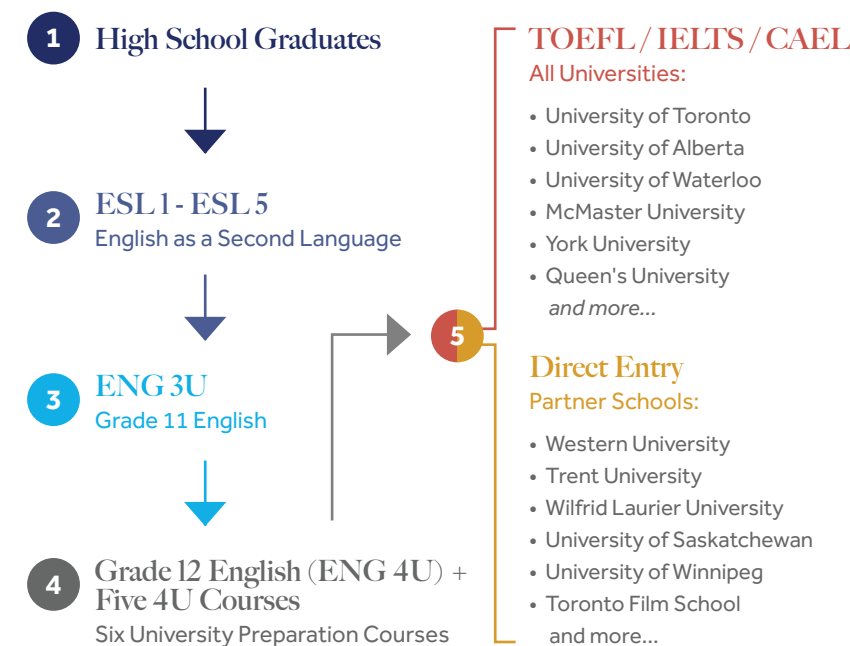

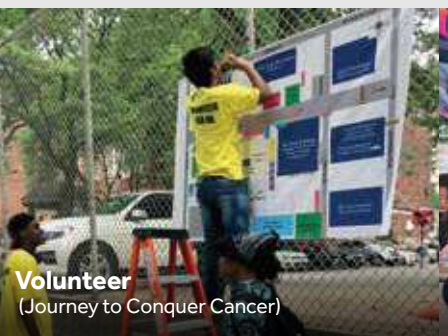
Outings and After-school Activities

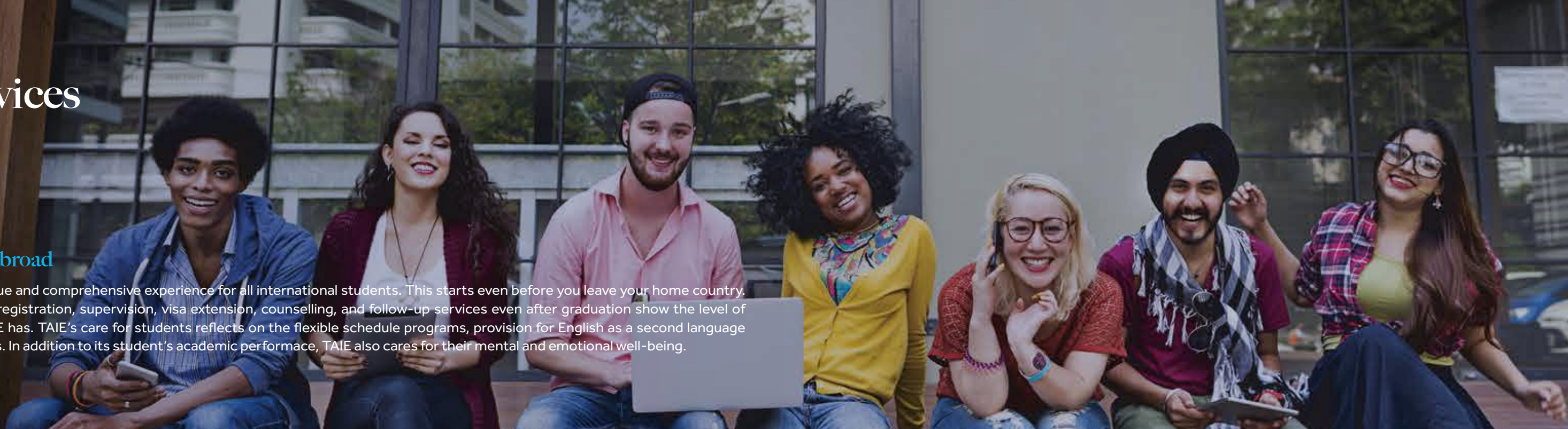

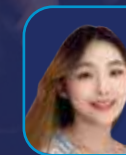

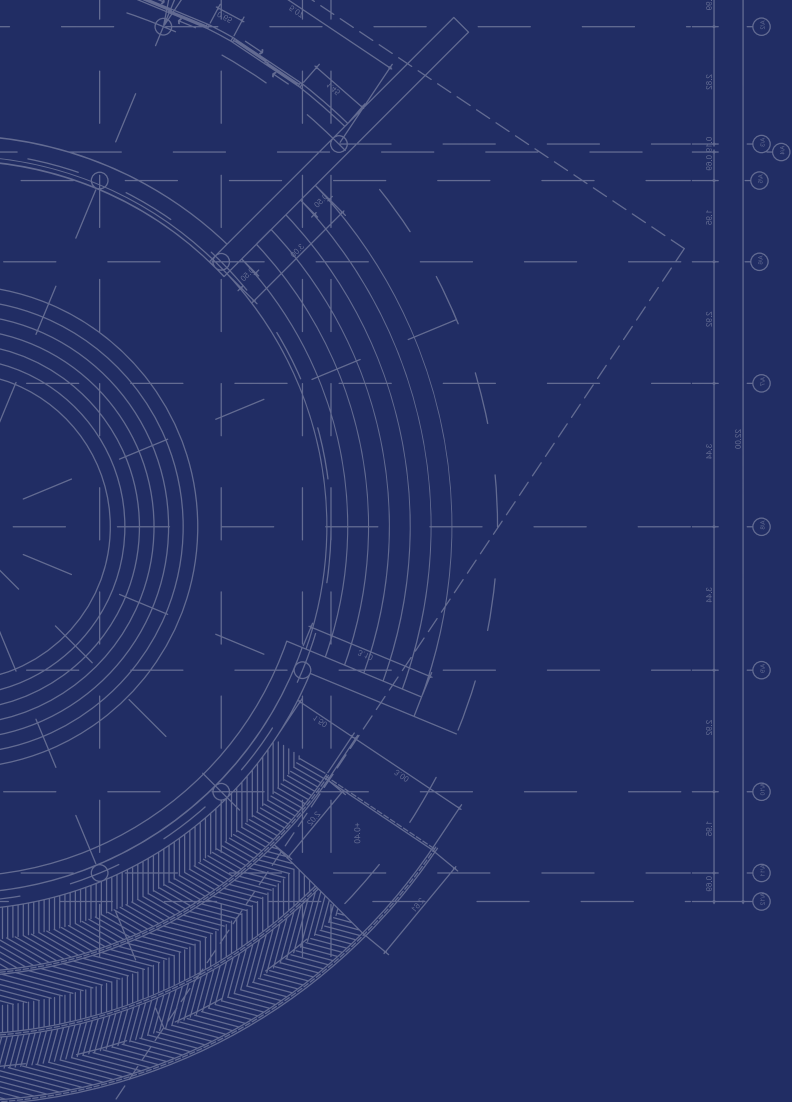
